The facilities provided in any particular area depend to a large degree on the demand and viability of such services. The provision of services can determine the viability of a settlement or area and the quality of life of its residents. It is important therefore that services and community facilities of an appropriate standard are provided for each resident of the County.

Kerry County Council has no direct role in the provision of many social facilities such as education and health services. The Council does, however, through the zoning of land in appropriate locations, and through the wider planning process, support and enable the development of social facilities.
