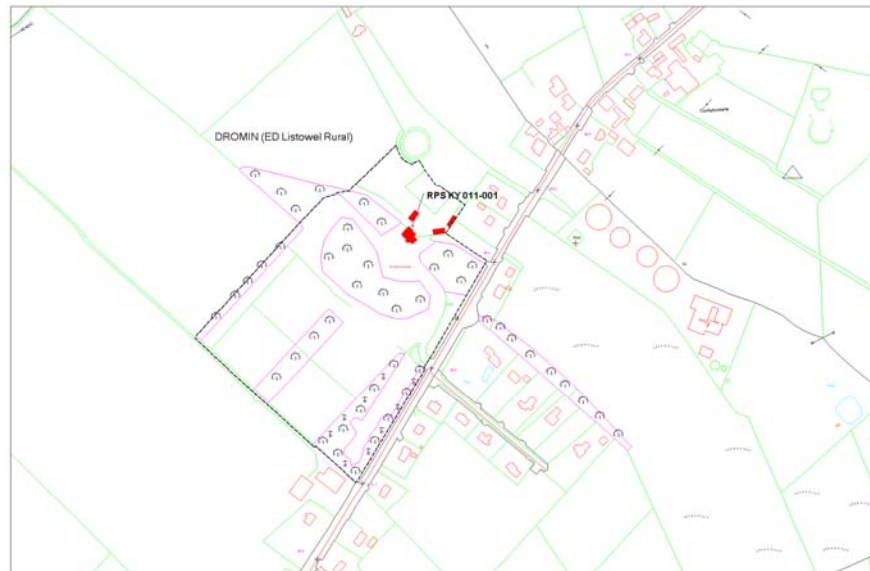

Appraisal: Dromin House was completed in 1668 for a William Fitzmaurice, 20th Lord of Kerry. A substantial residence with associated outbuildings, it is one of the oldest surviving private houses in Nth. Kerry. Built on a symmetrical plan the house is well proportioned and represents an important aspect of the architecture and history of Nth. Kerry and should be included in the RPS.
