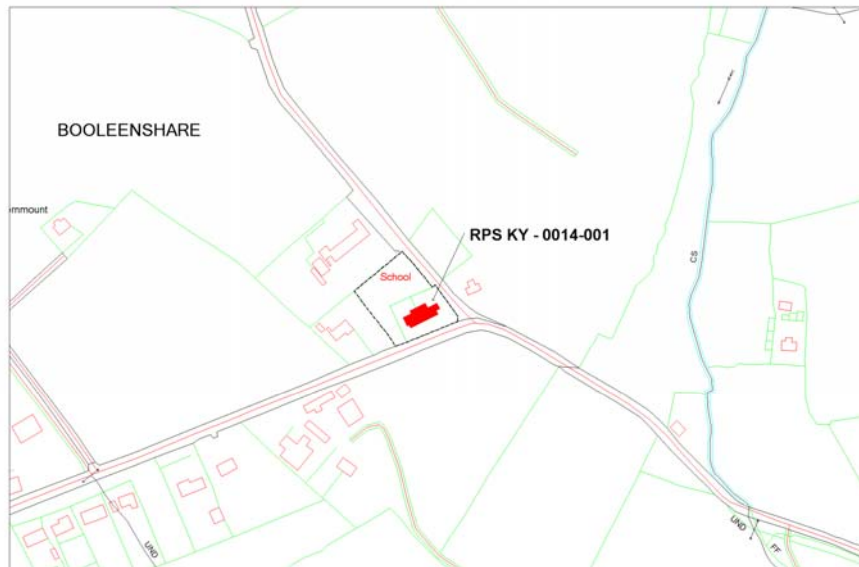

Appraisal: The original schoolhouse in Bouleenshare was opened in 1836, fifty years later in 1886 this building was opened and functioned as a school until the 1960s. The majority of the rural schools erected in the 1800s were relatively simple structures, this building has a complex roof and its overall design is unlike other such structures, The building has retained many external features, is significant from an architectural and social perspective and should be added to the RPS.
