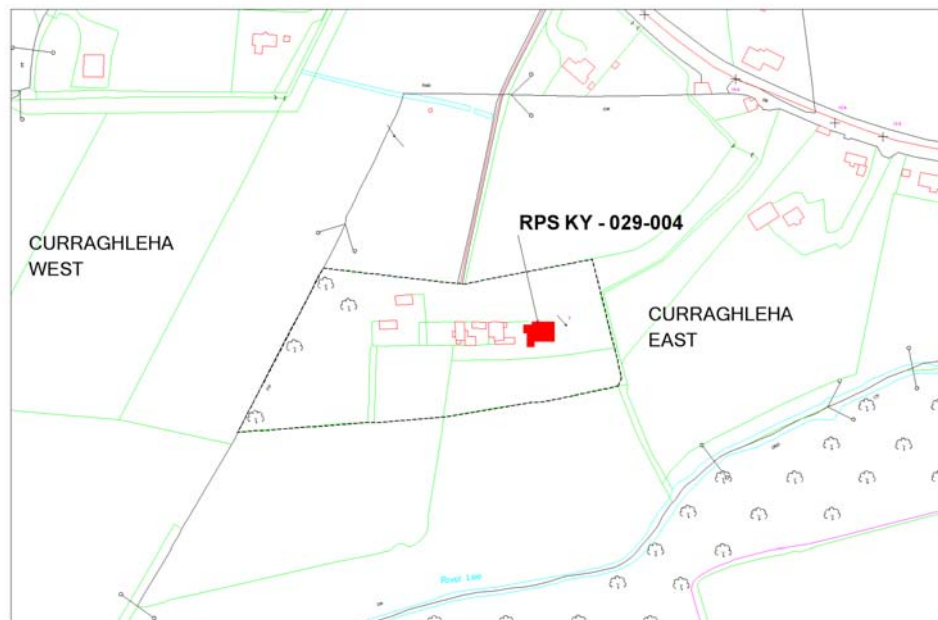

Appraisal: Impressive two storey structure with a hipped roof, wide overhanging eaves and a pedimented porch with large venetian window. Retains original gate lodge although now much altered. Built by the Chute family of Chute Hall in the late 18th century. This building is a significant element of the architectural heritage of the greater Tralee area and should be included in the RPS.
