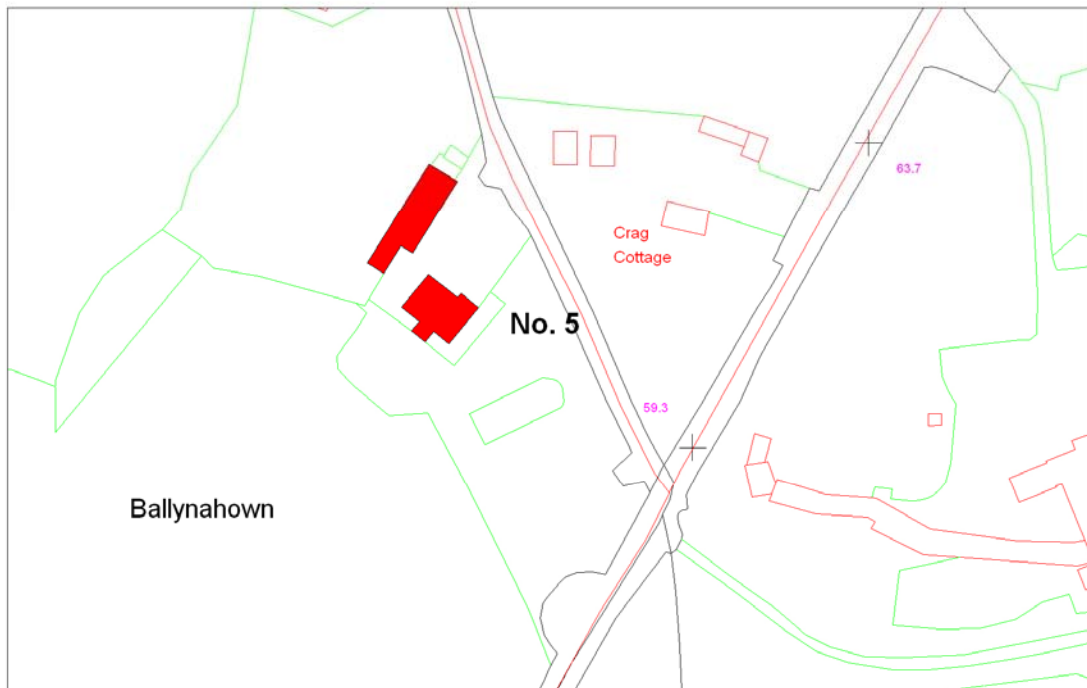

**Appraisal:** A good example of a classically designed medium sized country house with substantial outbuildings. Having been carefully maintained over the years much of the original fabric has been maintained. The house is believed to have been built in 1810 by Captain Henry Oliver.
