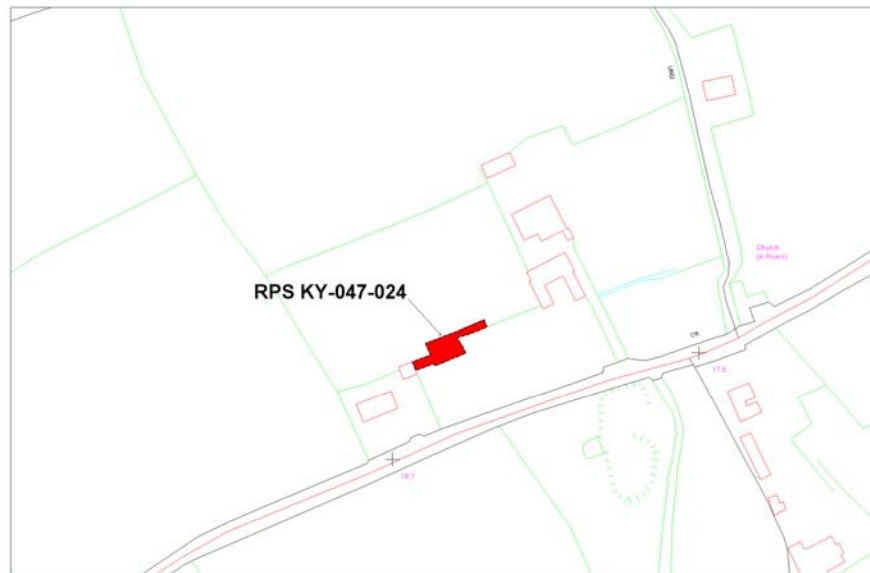

**Appraisal:** A very good example of a small Georgian dwelling house and one of the few remaining in Kerry. This carefully composed building retains its original appearance. It has wide sash windows and entrance door set within a segmental headed opening, dominated by two large robust chimneystacks. It is thought to date to the late 1700s and at one stage belonged to the Spring family. This building is significant from an architectural perspective and should be included in the RPS.
