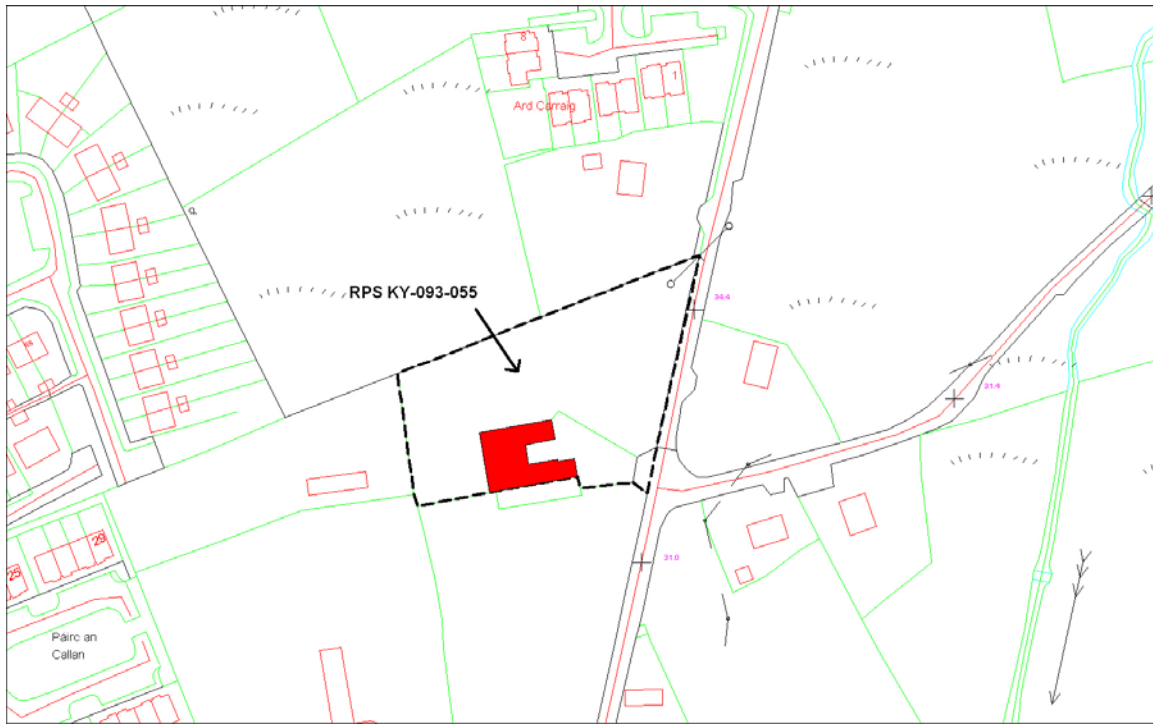

Appraisal: This building served as the workhouse during the Famine period and is now a private residence. This is a well composed building, retaining most of its original form and fabric, including a number of six over six sliding sash windows. The prominent quoin stones, the stone relieving arches over the windows and the robust chimney stacks all serve to enliven the design quality of the building. This building is of special social, historical and architectural interest and should be included in the RPS.
