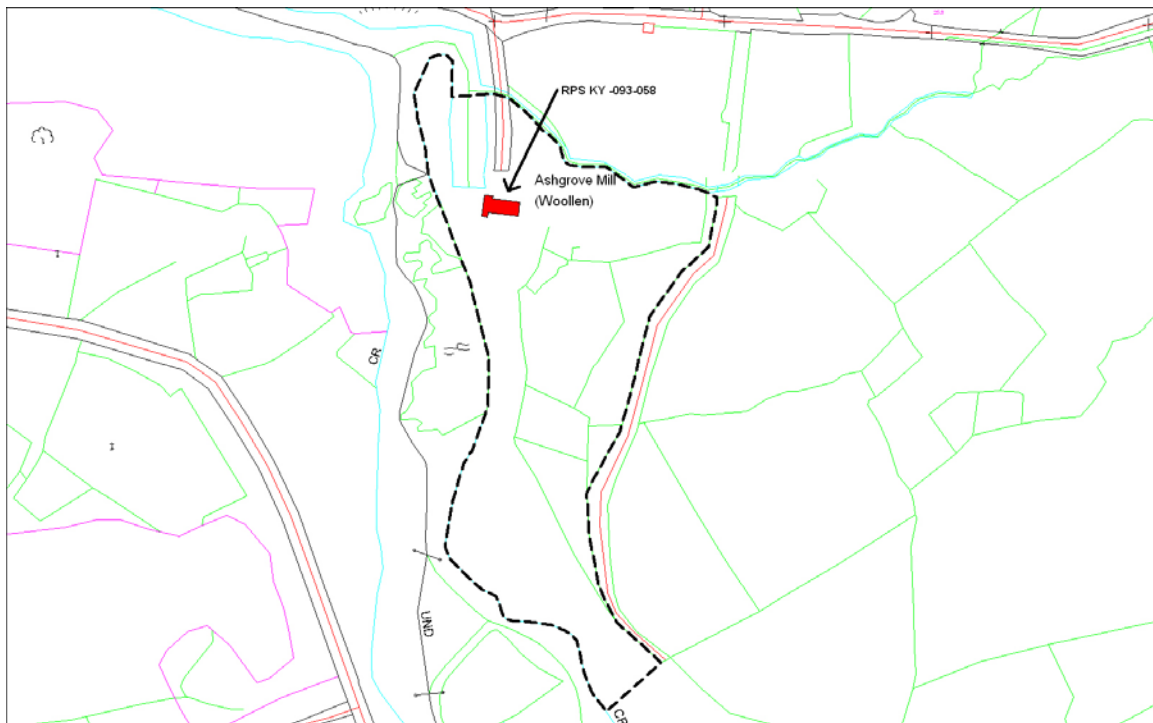

**Appraisal:** This mill was originally built for grinding maize but was subsequently used as a woolen mill. It was one of only a few woolen mills in the Munster area including Ardfinnan ( Co. Tipp.) and Beaufort to use a water turbine as a power source. The building represents an important aspect of the industrial archaeological heritage of the county. This structure is of special technical, historical and archaeological interest and should be included in the RPS.
