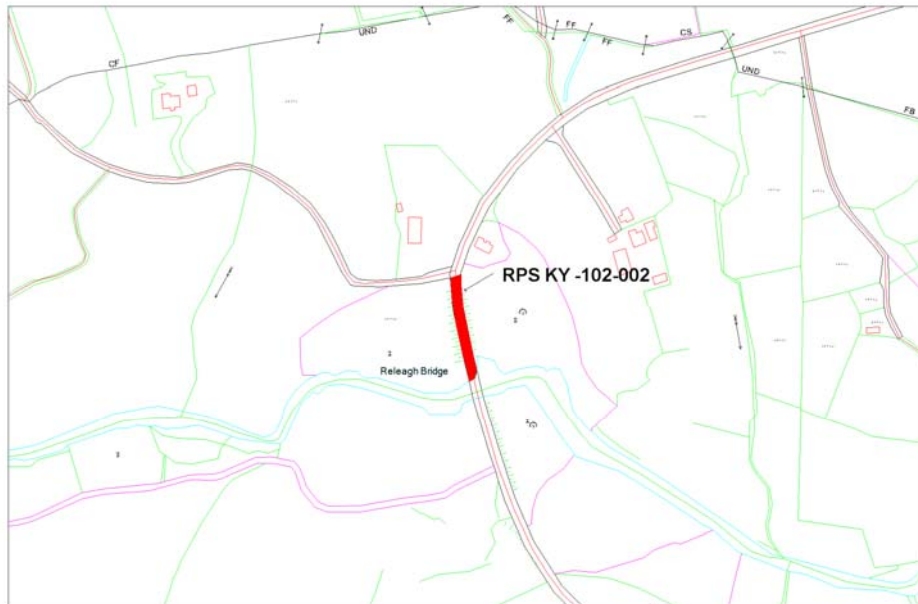

Appraisal: Completed in 1839 by the renowned surveyor, cartographer and civil engineer, William Bald. This was part of the new line across the mountains to connect Kenmare with Bantry. The overall project commenced in 1833 under the direction of Richard Griffith. This structure is a significant example of our architectural/engineering heritage and should be included in RPS.
